COMMUNIQUE

(COVID-19 UPDATE)

In accordance with the statement of the head of the World Health Organization (WHO), on May 5th, 2023, declaring the end of Covid-19 as a global health emergency, the Embassy of the Republic of Mali in Washington D.C. informs national and international communities that, given the low number of cases recorded in Mali in recent months, **the Covid-19 test** is no longer required as a travel document for entry into Mali.

However, vaccination against yellow fever certified by CDC Yellow Book for travelers remains an obligation for travelers to Mali.
